The book of Revelation is a theological panorama of human history, tracing the perennial conflict between good and evil at the end of the time till Christ's Second Coming.

It was given by God's angel to John, bishop of Ephesus, on the Greek island of Patmos, 96A.D. During the persecution by the Roman emperor, Domitian(81-96A.D.)

Revelation is also a prophetical vision of man's destiny, incorporating many Old Testament prophecies on the Day of the Lord and the future Davidic kingdom of Israel (Isaiah c.24,25; Ezechiel c. 36-39; Joel c.4; Zecheriah c.14). It is focused particulary on the eschatological (Greek escata=last things) end times or latter days of world history, hence it's greek title apocalypse, meaning to pull back the curtain or unveil the mystical secrets of the future. John encourages his persecuted people to persevere and the endure these satanic attacks, which are transient and futile, because ha assures them, the blood of the Lamb of God has already won the victory over evil, a very relevant message for our times to-day. The primary players in this apocalyptic drama are the Blessed Trinity of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, with his angels, the Church and God's people on one side, opposed by Lucifer, the devil and his three satanic beasts, namely

- (1) the "Red Dragoon" (12.13) (Marxist atheistic communism)
- (2) the "beast from the sea" (13.1) Anti-Christ, (Masonic iluminaty)
- (3) and the "beast from the earth" (13.11), the false prophet (ecclesiastical free masonry).

The four horseman of the apocalypse reveal the first four seals, which are listed in the synoptic gospels (Matthew c.24, Mark c.13, Luke c.21) as the first signs of distress before Christ's coming.

The first seal is te "white horse" (6.2) namely apostasy, including a Church schism, led by the False Prophet, a Roman cardinal, we are told, who will shortly force pope Benedict to leave Rome, probably coinciding with the unsealing of the

second seal, namely the "red horse" (6.3) of war, which may result from a sudden attack on Europe by the red Russian dragoon, backed by communist China and many Sunny muslim nations..?

This may be proceeded by a financial collapse and <u>currency</u> crisis, triggered off by the illuminati bankers, who will then instigate a war on Iran/Syria, led by Israel,USA & UK, and backed by the worldwide masonic media, who will first higlight the mediation role of the pseudo-messiah in the Middle East, as peace maker and wonder- worker extraordinary! This bloody war will be followed by the third seal, the "black

horse"(6.5)=famine, closely followed by the fourth seal, the "pale horse"(6.7)=plagues and epidemics.

Many of these will be a consequence of famine, but may also result from a biochemical war in the Middle East and the poisonous vaccination threatened by the New World Order. After being acclaimed as both Jewish messaiah and muslim Maitreya, the Anti-Christ will stage a world coup de-tat and 42 month tyranny, during which "the martyrs" of teh fifth seal(6.9) and the "great earthquake" the sixth seal (6.12) will probably take place.

The "two witnesses" (11.3-4) are two olives and the two lamps. The two lamps are The Christian Churches, the traditional true Church and those followers of Lord who will be cast aside by the False Prophet. The two Olive Trees are the Old Jerusalem Israel and the New Israel. They will preach the Word of God against Anti-Christ and convert many Jews and unbelievers during these 1260 days of the Great tribulation era.

Chapter 12 describes the woman of the apocalypse, symbolising Our Lady and the remnant Church, who will have to flee into "wilderness" during this three and half year period. Chapter 13 features the two satanic beasts, namely Anti-Christ and the False Prophet, when "no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark i.e.the name of the beast or the number of it's name"(13.17) which is "666"(13.18).

Then apeears the glorious "Son of Man"(14.14) and "the angels pour out on the earth the 7 bowls of God's wrath"(16.1) on those who "bear the mark of the beast and worshipped it's image"(16.2)

Chapter 16 contains "the great day of God the Almighty" (16.14) and the battle of "Armageddon" (16.16) when the Lord will destroy the armies of Anti-Christ (200 milion man) and St. Michael will cast the devil "into hell for 1000 years" (20.2).

Then "blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb" (19.9) for they shall enter the New Jeruzalem and live in the Millenium Kingdom of divine will on earth for the final 1000 years, before the last judgement and the end of the world. Chapter 22 describes this Eucharistic reign of God and the book of revelation reiterates the primary theme of Christ's coming or Parousia (Greek term for a royal Kingly visit and presence): "Behold I am coming soon"(22.7) concluding with the words: "surely I am coming soon, Amen, come Lord Jesus"(22.20) The Lord told Maria of Divine Mercy that he has sent new prophets to the world for three reasons:

1. To remind mankind of the truth contained in the Book of Revelation 2. To alert man to the times he lives in, so as to rekindle his faith 3. To help spread conversion, so that Lords followers can form the biggerst army to save souls, and His Word is heared in every country worldwide. God choose Maria as His prophet or spokesperson, to highlight the truths of the Book of Revelation and prepare people for Christ's second coming.

The apocalyptic Book of Daniel(O.T.) describes the fourth beast, Antiochus Epiphanes(11.21)& the "abomination of desolation"

(Matt.24.15) during this three and a half year of tyranny, is a proto-type of Anti-Christ, and Daniel has the key massianic term used by Jesus himself: "The Son of Man"(18.17), also supplying the book title for Maria - "The Book of Truth"(10.21) The synoptic Gospels have three apocalyptic chapters (Matt.c.24,Mark c.13, Luke c.21), that list apostasy as the first sign of the end times, then wars, earthquakes, famines, plagues and signs in the sun, moon and stars to accompany the coming of the Son of Man,while all conclude with an appeal for prayerful watchfulness. Three Epistles, 1John c.2;11 Peter c.3; & 11 Thessalonians c.2 are apocalyptic too and St.Paul refers to the "wicked/lawless/evil one, the man of sin and instrument of evil"(Anti-Christ).

Our Lady, who was predestined to crush the head of the serpent(Gen.3.15), appeared as the woman of the Apocalypse to launch the Marian Age at the Rue De Bac, 1830, and has been our primary prophetical source since, as at La Salette, 1846, where she warned of clerical apostacy, Church schism and the advent of Anti-Christ, calling on the apostles of the latter days to stand up and enlighten the world. The miracle of the sun at Fatima,1917, was a truly apocalyptic sign, and Lucia said the Third Secret, (1925) was all the Gospels and the Apocalypse c.8-14, while Mary's messages to the Marian movement 1973-97, revealed many apocalyptic secrets to fr.Gobbi, particularly in 1988-1989; in 1961-1965 at Garabandal,Our Lady promised The Warning or an Illumination of Conscience, like a near-death, judgement experience, to convert the world before Anti-Christ, as Maria explains in the Book of Truth.
